The Essequibo River lies entirely within the South American country of Guyana, and is the largest river between the Orinoco and Amazon.

The form of this shanty is a triple call and response, with the third call & response unchanged throughout the song. This is usually a good indicator of the song being originating as a slave song, probably first used for jobs ashore where pulling is needed: moving shanty huts; working cargo, etc.
