First Thing In The Morning

Semantics: Using adverbial vocabulary General vocabulary & development of concepts

First thing in the morning, what do you do?

Jump, jump, jump out of bed

Prosody: Questions, rhythmic use of words

Pragmatics: Linking meaning of words to activity

Syntax: Word order for question & adverbial vocabulary Simple verbs "jump", "wash" etc

Next you're in the bathroom, what do you do? Wash, wash, wash, wash your face

Question

Then go to the kitchen, what do you do?

Eat, eat, eat, eat your breakfast

Repetition of verb in each phrase

Adverbs "first", "next", "then", "after", "finally" After you have eaten, what do you do?

Brush, brush, brush, brush your teeth

Activities:

Finally you're ready, what do you do? walk, walk, walk, walk to school

Use picture flashcards of "bathroom" etc to illicit vocabulary and phrase responses
Expand verb phrase i.e. "eat" = "I'll eat", "she'll be eating", "he ate", "he's eaten" etc.
