Four leaves today

Practice the phonology
of the words
“crunching, munching”
by repeating them
rhythmically to create
an accompaniment to
the song

Activities:

Expand the use of prepositions by
replacing “sitting next to me”, e.g. “sitting
over there”, “underneath the chair” etc

Expand vocabulary
by replacing the
words “caterpillar”,
“lunch”, “leaves”
